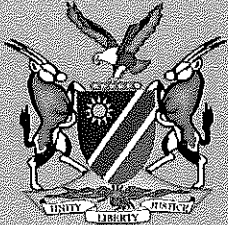

## **SECTION I: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS**

### **1. Rights of Public Entity**

The *Oshana Regional Council* reserves the right:

- (a) to split the contract as per the lowest evaluated cost per lot;
- (b) to accept or reject any quotation or to cancel the quotation process and reject all quotations at any time prior to contract award.

### **2. Preparation of Quotations**

You are requested to quote for the works mentioned in Section III, by completing, signing and returning:

- (a) the Quotation Letter in Section II with its annex for Bid Securing Declaration, where applicable;
- (b) the Priced Activity Schedule in Section IV;
- (c) the Specifications and Compliance Sheet in Section V; and
- (d) any other attachment as deemed appropriate

You are advised to carefully read the complete Request for Quotations document, including the Special Conditions of Contract in Section VII, before preparing your Quotation. The standard forms in this document may be retyped for completion but the Bidder is responsible for their accurate reproduction.

### **3. Validity of Quotations**

**The quotation validity period shall be 90 days from the date of bid submission deadline.**

### **4. Eligibility Criteria**

To be eligible to participate in this Quotation exercise, you should:

- (a) have a valid company Registration Certificate;
- (b) have an original or certified copy of valid good Standing Tax Certificate from NAMRA;
- (c) have an original or certified copy of valid good Standing Social Security Certificate;
- (d) have a valid certified copy of Affirmative Action Compliance Certificate, proof from Employment Equity Commissioner that bidder is not a relevant employer, or exemption issued in terms of Section 42 of the Affirmative Action Act, 1998;
- (e) Submit signed Bid-Securing Declaration.

### **5. Bid Security/Bid Securing Declaration**

Bidders are required to submit a signed Bid Securing Declaration for this procurement process.

## **6. Delivery**

Delivery shall be within *30 days* after acceptance/issue of Purchase Order. Deviation in delivery period *shall be considered if such deviation is reasonable*.

## **7. Sealing and Marking of Quotations**

Quotations should be sealed in a single envelope, clearly marked with the Procurement Reference Number, addressed to the Oshana Regional Council Procurement Management Unity (PMU) with the Bidder's name at the back of the envelope.

## **8. Submission of Quotations**

Quotations should be deposited in the Quotation/Bid Box located at PMU, Oshana Regional Council, Leo Shoopala Street, not later than 12 June 2025, at 11h00am. Quotations by post or hand delivered should reach the same address by the same date and time at latest. Late quotations will be rejected. Quotations received by e-mail will not be considered.

## **9. Opening of Quotations**

Quotations will be opened internally by the Oshana Regional Council immediately after the closing time referred to in section 8 above. A record of the Quotation Opening stating the name of the bidders, the amount quoted, the presence or absence of a Bid Security/Bid Securing Declaration, will be posted on the website of the Public Entity and available to any bidder on request within three working days of the Opening.

## **10. Evaluation of Quotations**

The Oshana Regional Council shall have the right to request for clarifications in writing during evaluation. Offers that are substantially responsive shall be compared on the basis of evaluated cost, subject to Margin of Preference where applicable, to determine the lowest evaluated quotation.

## **11. Technical Compliance**

The Specifications and Compliance Sheet details the minimum specifications of the works to be carried out. The specifications have to be met, but no credit will be given for exceeding the specifications.

## **12. Prices and Currency of Payment**

Prices for the execution of works shall be fixed in Namibian Dollars as quoted.

Quotations shall cover all costs of labour, materials, equipment, overheads, profits and all associated costs for performing the works, and shall include all duties. The whole cost of performing the works shall be included in the items stated, and the cost of any incidental works shall be deemed to be included in the prices quoted.
